Dead Tree Removal Policy

I. Purpose:

It is the intention of the Board of Trustees to preserve the woodlands environment and naturally wooded image of Walden on Lake Conroe, while ensuring a safe and healthful environment for all residents.

II. General:

While the preservation of healthy trees has been addressed in the Tree Preservation Policy, the removal of dead trees is implied in the deed restrictions but not specifically addressed. Therefore, this Policy is set forth to clarify the deed restrictions and to express the intent of the Board.

III. Policy:

Upon discovery of a dead tree on a property that is <u>not developed</u>, the Association may take pictures of the tree to document the situation. This documentation may be reviewed by a Master Gardner or Arborist. The Association will give 10 days written notice to the property owner to ask that the tree be removed. After the 10 days if the tree has not been removed, the Association, in its sole discretion, without liability to the property owner or occupant of the property in trespass or otherwise, may enter the property, remove the dead tree and any natural vegetation debris, and bill the property owner for these services. If the invoice for these services remains unpaid after 30 days, the amount may be added to the maintenance account for that property.

Upon the discovery of a dead tree on a property that is <u>developed</u>, the owner will be notified in writing and asked to have the tree removed in 30 days. The property owner may contact the Association if they believe the tree is not dead, and ask for a review by a Master Gardener or Arborist. If the property owner does not contact the Association after 30 days, or if the determination of the Master Gardener or Arborist is that the tree is dead and the owner does not remove the tree, the Association, in its sole discretion, without liability to the property owner or occupant of the property in trespass or otherwise, may enter the property, remove the dead tree and any natural vegetation debris, and bill the property owner for these services. If the invoice for these services remains unpaid after 30 days, the amount may be added to the maintenance account for that property.
